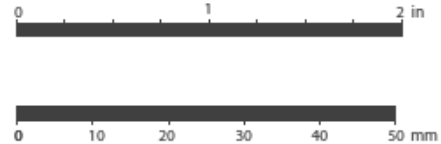




Ring Clock – a guide to measure the correct size

Check the printing accuracy

1. Print this guide at 100% page scale
2. Check the printing accuracy by measuring the bar on the right (2 inch or 50 mm)



Paper test A version

1. Carefully cut out the 'A' paper Ring Clock sizer at the bottom of the page.
2. Create a slit by making a small cut on the line between 'Clock' and 'US' words
3. Slide the pointed end through the slit creating a ring
4. Put it on your finger and pull the pointed end to create a snug fit
5. The number line located at the slit should be the correct ring size

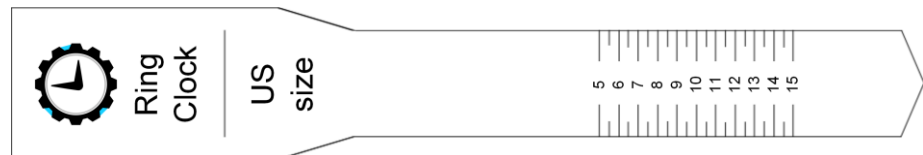
Paper test B version

1. Carefully cut out the 'B' paper Ring Clock sizer at the bottom of the page.
2. Make a cut on the line between 'Clock' and 'US' words
3. Make a cut on the line where you predict for your size to be
4. Slide the two slot into each other and make a ring shape
5. Try it on your finger and feel if it is comfortable

Tips

1. Be careful not make the paper wrap too tight. Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.
2. Use both (A and B) tests for optimum accuracy
3. If you are between two sizes, always choose the larger one.
4. Measure when the fingers are at room temperature.
